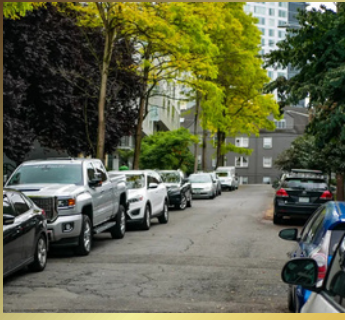

Parking Reminder:

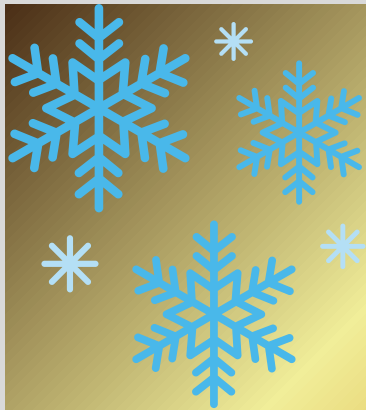
As we head into the holiday season, we know many of you will have family and friends visiting. We love having guests but please make sure they park off-street, as parking spots are reserved for residents only.
